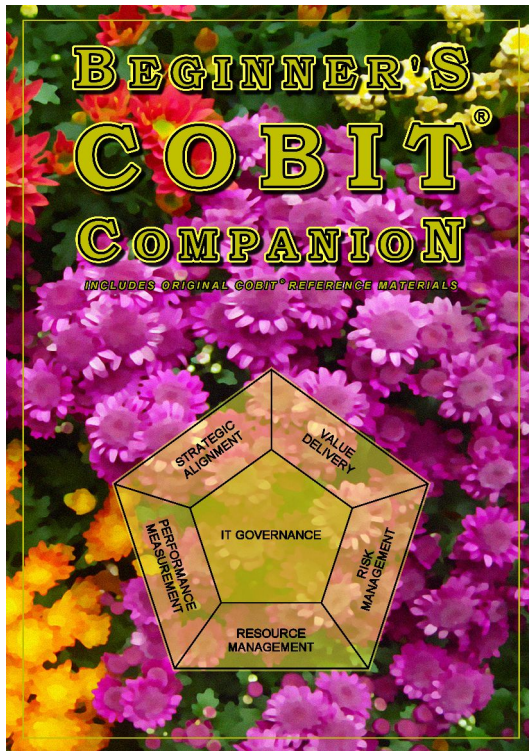


BEGINNER'S COBIT® COMPANION
